

Degrees of Punishment and Reward

Here are listed scriptures which indicate there will be degrees of punishment as well as degrees of reward and discretion on the Day of Judgment.

Punishment:

Matthew 10:15 I assure you, the wicked cities of Sodom and Gomorrah will be **better off on the judgment day** than that place will be.

Matthew 11:24 I assure you, Sodom will be **better off on the judgment day** than you."

Matthew 23:14

ESV ["Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites, because you devour widows' houses, and for a pretense you make long prayers; therefore you will receive **greater condemnation.**"]

KJV Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayer: therefore ye shall receive the **greater damnation.**

-There will be greater and lesser damnation.

Mark 9:42 "Whoever causes one of these little ones who believe to stumble, **it would be better** for him if, with a heavy millstone hung around his neck, he had been cast into the sea.

-This implies there are greater and lesser condemnations.

Mark 12:40 who devour widows' houses, and for appearance's sake offer long prayers; these will receive **greater condemnation.**"

Luke 10:12-14

12 The truth is, even wicked Sodom will be **better off** than such a town on the judgment day.

13 "What horrors await you, Korazin and Bethsaida! For if the miracles I did in you had been done in wicked Tyre and Sidon, their people would have sat in deep repentance long ago, clothed in sackcloth and throwing ashes on their heads to show their remorse.

14 Yes, Tyre and Sidon will be **better off on the judgment day** than you.

You can be better or worse off on judgment day.

Luke 12:47 "That servant who knows his master's will and does not get ready or does not do what his master wants will be **beaten with many blows.** 48 But **the one who does not know** and does things deserving punishment will be **beaten with few blows.** From everyone who has been given much, much will be demanded; and from the one who has been entrusted with much, much more will be asked.

Luke 20:47 who devour widows' houses, and for appearance's sake offer long prayers. These will receive **greater condemnation.**"

There is greater and lesser condemnation.

John 19:11 Then Jesus said, "You would have no power over me at all unless it were given to you from above. So the one who brought me to you has the **greater sin.**"

There is greater and lesser sin.

James 2:13 because **judgment without mercy will be shown to anyone who has not been merciful.** Mercy triumphs over judgment!

There will be mercy on judgment day and it will be given to those who have been merciful in this life.

James 3:1 Not many of you should presume to be teachers, my brothers, because you know that we who teach **will be judged more strictly.**

There will be more and less strict judgment on judgment day.

Degrees of Punishment and Reward

2Peter 2:20 If they have escaped the corruption of the world by knowing our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and are again entangled in it and overcome, they are **worse off at the end than they were at the beginning.**

Some conditions will be worse than others.

Reward:

Matthew 5:12 Rejoice and be glad, because **great is your reward** in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

Matthew 10:41-42

41 Anyone who receives a prophet because he is a prophet will **receive a prophet's reward**, and anyone who receives a righteous man because he is a righteous man will receive **a righteous man's reward.**

42 And if anyone gives even a cup of cold water to one of these little ones because he is my disciple, I tell you the truth, he will certainly not lose his reward."

Matthew 16:27 For the Son of Man is going to come in his Father's glory with his angels, and then he will reward each person **according to what he has done.**

1Corinthians 3:13-15

13 his work will be shown for what it is, because the Day will bring it to light. It will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test the quality of each man's work.

14 If what he has built survives, he will receive his reward.

15 If it is burned up, **he will suffer loss; he himself will be saved, but only as one escaping through the flames.**

Hebrews 11:35 Women received back their dead, raised to life again. Others were tortured and refused to be released, so that they might gain **a better resurrection.**

Discretion

These verses indicate there will be discretion on that day.

Matthew 10:41-42

41 **Anyone who receives a prophet because he is a prophet** will receive a prophet's reward, and anyone who **receives a righteous man because he is a righteous man** will receive a righteous man's reward.

42 And **if anyone gives even a cup of cold water to one of these little ones** because he is my disciple, I tell you the truth, he will certainly not lose his reward."

Matthew 12:41-42

41 **The men of Nineveh will stand up at the judgment with this generation and condemn it;** for they repented at the preaching of Jonah, and now one greater than Jonah is here.

42 **The Queen of the South will rise at the judgment with this generation and condemn it;** for she came from the ends of the earth to listen to Solomon's wisdom, and now one greater than Solomon is here.

Matthew 18:33-35

33 Shouldn't you have had **mercy on your fellow servant** just as I had on you?'

34 In anger his master turned him over to the jailers to be tortured, until he should pay back all he owed.

Degrees of Punishment and Reward

35 "This is how my heavenly Father will treat each of you **unless you forgive your brother from your heart.**"

Acts 7:59 While they were stoning him, Stephen prayed, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit." 60 Then he fell on his knees and cried out, "Lord, **do not hold this sin against them.**" When he had said this, he fell asleep.

Romans 4:5 However, to the man who does not work but trusts God who justifies the wicked, his **faith is credited as righteousness.**

Romans 9:18 Therefore **God has mercy on whom he wants to have mercy**, and he hardens whom he wants to harden.

2Timothy 4:16 At my first defense, no one came to my support, but everyone deserted me. **May it not be held against them.**

2Timothy 1:15-18

15 You know that everyone in the province of Asia has deserted me, including Phygelus and Hermogenes.

16 **May the Lord show mercy to the household of Onesiphorus**, because he often refreshed me and was not ashamed of my chains.

17 On the contrary, when he was in Rome, he searched hard for me until he found me.

18 **May the Lord grant that he will find mercy from the Lord on that day!** You know very well in how many ways he helped me in Ephesus.

James 5:20 remember this: **Whoever turns a sinner from the error of his way will save him from death and cover over a multitude of sins.**

1Peter 4:8 Above all, love each other deeply, because **love covers over a multitude of sins.**
